17th Annual *Bud Atchison* Junior Ringin' Ten Scratch Invitational

Star Lanes, Butte, Montana - November 18, 2018

The tournament will consist of THREE scratch divisions. "Division A" will be for averages 165 and over. "Division B" will be for averages 134-164, "Division C" will be for averages 133 and under. There will be a \$200 Scholarship guaranteed for the champion in each division. Other finalists in the "Final Four" will be awarded scholarships. The champion in each division will receive a plaque.

One-day Format: Sunday, November 18th **Check-in 8:45AM
Practice 9:15AM - Competition begins at 9:30AM**

You will bowl 5 (five) Qualifying games crossing lanes each game.

Top 8 bowlers in each division will advance to the round robin where each division will be divided into two pools of four bowlers, drawn randomly. Depending on participation advancers may be reduced or increased. SCORES START FRESH. You will bowl a one-game match play against three other bowlers in your pool receiving total actual pins knocked down and 30 bonus pins for a win. In case of ties, 15 pins will be awarded to each bowler. After completion of pool play there will be a one-game position round between bowlers of both pools ranked according to pin fall plus bonus pins to determine the top four. These "Final Four" in each division will bowl the Eliminator Format. Scores start fresh. The player who bowls the lowest score in the first game is eliminated and the other three advance to the second round where the same format applies. The two survivors of each division will bowl one more game to determine the champion. Presentation of Awards will follow the final match.

This tournament is USBC Youth Certified. All entrants must be USBC Youth members; membership cards are required at check-in. Scholarships will be handled by the SMART Program account #2069. This tournament will use last year's highest final USBC league average. If you do not have a last year's final average your highest current USBC league average (minimum 9 games) as of 11/16/18 will be used. If neither average is established and verified, you will bowl in Division A. Averages are used for division placement only. Tournament Manager and Committee decisions are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
