

# SIDELIGHTS ON BOWLING

By L. E. JONES, President Montana State Bowling Association, 1934

The question was asked, "How did the game of bowling start?" It is an ancient game. One authority traces the game back to the twelfth century while Strutt, an English author, holds that the game probably originated during the middle ages (A. D. 400-1500). Possibly no writer did more to acquaint a large number about the sport of bowling than Washington Irving, who in his imaginative mind tells us about Rip Van Winkle, who took a 20-year sleep after watching those quaint little fellows playing nine pins.

In the early days, stone spheres are known to have been used for bowling. The game was played on open greens. Later a single board about one foot wide was embedded in the center of the alley and in the open, from which we have the modern bowling alley of today.

The game of nine pins enjoyed great popularity for a time, but because of the enactment of a law against this sport, a tenth pin was added and the game of ten pins played much as it is today immediately sprang into favor. The first bowling in America was brought here by the Dutch to Manhattan Island in 1623. It was in 1875 that delegates from nine bowling clubs met in New York City and organized the National Bowling Association. This association was the first to make an endeavor to regulate the game of bowling. They determined the regulation length of the alleys, size of balls required, "dead wood" to be removed from the alleys and disbarred balls bowled in the gutters. The dead line was made to measure 60 feet from the center of the head pin spot to the bowlers' end of the alley. Due to the fact the association was not large enough to secure proper recognition, it went out of existence, as well as its successor, American Amateur Bowling Union which was organized in 1890. It was in September, 1895, that the American Bowling Congress was organized and since then has been recognized as the supreme court of bowling. The first national tournament of this organization was held at Chicago, January 8-11, 1901, with 41 competing teams.

Today more than 7,000,000 men and women in the U.S. are interested in bowling. More than 20,000 buildings, churches, clubs, fraternal organizations and industrial establishments are occupied by bowling alleys. It is estimated that they house 160,000 bowling alleys.

The investment will reach nearly 260 millions of dollars. Adding to this the investment in factories, materials, privately owned balls and equipment, it would be safe to say that 400 millions of dollars are invested. It is estimated that each bowling alley averages in receipts \$6.00 per day, so it will be seen that the bowlers spend nearly a million dollars a day for the pleasure.

There is a reason for the continued increased interest in the art of bowling. There is no other sport that offers more inducements. The sociability and good fellowship combined by probably the most healthful of indoor recreations, an ideal health building sport, a recreation that exercises, rests and recreates, all at the same time. It develops character building qualities as self control, patience, honesty and courtesy. That is why, once a bowler, always a bowler.

### A SUGGESTION

Why not have a state telegraphic bowling shoot, similar to the state trap shoot. Here's how it can be accomplished.

Each week, select the five high average men in your major league. Have them roll as a team representing your city, against similar teams selected in the other cities. Their average should aggregate between 940 and 960 in order to keep all teams as near equal as possible.

Do the same with the boosters; their averages should aggregate between 850 and 870.

In your city, the major and the booster team to pace each other, rolling on your own alleys either Saturday night, or Sunday afternoon, against similar major and booster teams rolling in the other cities.

The scores to be sent to a designated headquarters to be decided upon later. There will be no handicaps.

Both the Major and the Booster teams will be given standings based on games won and lost. Each city will compete against another city on a set-up schedule.

Every city with four or more alleys will be eligible to compete.
