TO THE QUEEN

Montana's Bowling Queen for 1937 is indeed well-chosen. Her comeliness and her pleasing personality are certainly very fitting to one of regal rank.

The selection of a Queen to preside over the State Tournament festivities is an innovation in the annals of bowling in Montana. Is the idea not worth perpetuating solely from the standpoint of creating interest on the part of those not directly associated with the game itself?

The success and continued progress of the bowling game is after all more or less dependent upon the amount of financial aid secured. We have but one medium through which to obtain this aid—publicity. Through the selection of a Queen each year additional publicity is obtained, hence, it is only natural to assume that the financial assistance proffered would likewise be materially increased.

AN ALL-MONTANA BOWLING TEAM

Our President, Arthur Merkle, is the originator of the idea that an All-Montana Bowling Team be selected for 1937. Further, he has suggested to the American Bowling Congress that they likewise select an All-American Bowling Team. Secretary Baumgarten thought the idea well worth while and will bring the matter up for consideration at the annual meeting of the A. B. C.

The All-Montana Bowling Team for 1937 will be named at the completion of the 22nd Annual Tournament of the Montana Bowling Association. Members of the team will be the five high all-event bowlers in the tournament.

The State Secretary will advise each bowling alley in the State, the name and score of each member of this team.

As soon as convenient the five members of this team will get together for a group picture. One picture will be furnished to each bowling alley in the State and one shall be retained for publication in future State Tournament Programs.

“WHY DOES BOWLING ENJOY SUCH POPULARITY?”

A well-known writer has offered the following explanation:

Entirely beyond the appeal of the game as a game, the critical analyst will see in it something which we, who live under increasing pressure, have been mutely crying for. In college we got it easily in gang formation by smashing up the town after the big game—and in adult life many still achieve it by attending conventions, getting marvelously tight and throwing the furniture out of hotel windows.

In short, the savage in us still rebels at the damnable orderliness of conventional civilization. Individually, we are afraid to flaunt public opinion; in a sympathetic group we are delighted to blow things helter-skelter. Hence the popularity of bowling.

For the essence of bowling is that it permits the most straight-laced citizen to unbend long enough to blast into utter confusion a regimental array of ten neatly arranged objects. A monkey-like pin boy puts them there, row upon row in tantalizing perfection, and for the small price of twenty cents you can crash that orderliness into a shambles with a sixteen-pound missile, and win the cheers of your compatriots too!

Verily, bowling is a swell game. And while those who know their business recommend it as a breeder of better industrial relations—and others advocate it as a healthy form of exercise for the immature and aged—and still others favor it because it is an ideal conditioner for the sedentary—I like it because bowling is the civilized man's last chance to make a hell of a racket without apologizing to a soul!
