### 24 Points of Good Bowling

- 1. Dash into the alleys two minutes before starting time when it's an important match. This soothes your teammate's nerves.
- 2. Test the sliding qualities of each runway three or four times before each pitch. This always proves you are an expert.
- 3. Wait until your opponent is ready to roll before going after your ball. He will surely want to kiss you if you do this often enough.
- 4. If the pitch isn't coming up fast enough, dash across the next three alleys, using either a body check or rolling block upon anyone in your path. This is a sure dividend payer in time.
- 5. When the ball is headed for the pocket, start backing away from the foul lines, slowly at first, gradually increasing speed until at the moment of impact you land in somebody's lap.
- 6. After delivering the ball, stand at the foul line. Whirl sharply just as your opponent arrives at the mark, or better still, edge over slightly onto his runway. Do this enough and you have no need to worry about an old-age pension.
- Pick up all cigarettes and cigars you happen to see parked on the score board. This cuts down the expense of the game considerably.
- 8. Carefully examine your thumb after every wild heave. If you wiss the spare, glare at the pin boy and tell him to keep his greasy fingers out of the holes.
- 9. Give the foul judge an argument if your light goes on. He probably has something against your Aunt Ella and is taking spite out on you.
- 10. At every opportunity, explain in great detail about the time you struck out and won by one pin. If your audiences seem unappreciative, tell them about the split you picked off last week. Nobody but you has ever had those experiences.
- 11. After picking out the best ball, run and stand in front of the favorite alley, thus giving no one else a chance to bowl theirs.
- 12. Before throwing the ball, have your Captain call attention of new bowlers to your perfect stance.
- 13. If you make a strike, look around and smile.
- 14. If you make two strikes, calmly walk over and chalk them up, being careful not to smile this time.
- 15. If you make three strikes, nonchalantly light a cigarette. If you don't smoke, light one anyhow, and talk about living right.
- 16. If you throw your ball in the gutter, grab your leg quickly and limp to the bench, muttering something about your slippery shoes or the bad breaks.
- 17. If you have a railroad, study the situation very carefully, meanwhile thinking of the good time you had on your vacation. After you are sure you've formed a good impression, try and make it.
- 18. If you have a low score, tell your Captain, confidentially, that you did it for the sole purpose of getting a bigger handicap. If you haven't your bowling shoes, or if you haven't your own ball, remember, these are only good excuses for low scores.
- 19. If a bowler on the oposign team makes a bum shot, laugh as loud as possible and thus attract everyone's attention to it.
- 20. If your opponent makes a strike, always sneer and talke about horseshoes and four-leaf clovers.
- 21. Never give the other team any credit. Always talk about how funny they throw the ball, and if they go over the foul line, ask them if they're going to pay the pin boy a social visit.
- 22. If a man falls, dance around with joy for about a minute, then put in your strike.
- 3. When marking score, look around, and if no one is watching you, chalk up a few more than you made.
- 24. If you miss an easy spare, laugh and say you tried something new.
