THE MONTANA BOWLING ASSOCIATION

As we enter the twenty-seventh year of our existence as an organization which was founded on a non-profit basis for the purpose of promoting bowling in Montana we may find it interesting to look backwards into the life of our organization from the time of its conception to the present.

The first tournament held in Montana under the supervision of the Montana Bowling Association was rolled on the Home Plate Alleys in Great Falls in 1915. In 1916 our host was Anaconda and in 1917 our bowlers were entertained by Lewistown. During 1918 and 1919 most of the able bodied men of this territory were busy either in the settlement of the World War or as members of the army of occupation in Germany. Our tournaments were therefore discontinued but were resumed with new life in Butte in 1920.

The growth of the tournaments, which have been held by the Montana Bowling Association, has been phenomenal, yet today we stand on new horizons with a future before us which is most bright. We have lived to see the passing of the old and inadequate bowling establishments. In their place we have new modern establishments which bid us welcome. Our Annual Tournament has grown and continues to grow not only in size but in facilities and organization. Today we believe the conditions under which we operate to be second to none. We are ever appreciative of the fact that we have been aided in our growth by the American Bowling Congress and other interested organizations but we also recognize the fact that our continued growth rests, to a very great extent, with ourselves. To guarantee our success we must continually work together, each believing that Montana and surrounding territory offers to all an opportunity to live as only those of us who have lived here know how to live and to bowl as those who have bowled here know how to bowl.

Let's boost for an ever awakening public, one which will continually increase its recognition of the wonders of Montana and its surrounding territory.

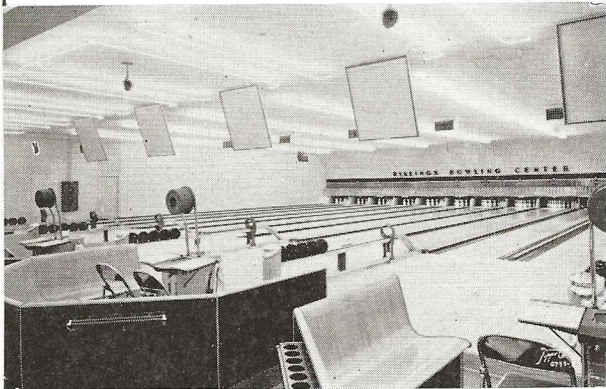
