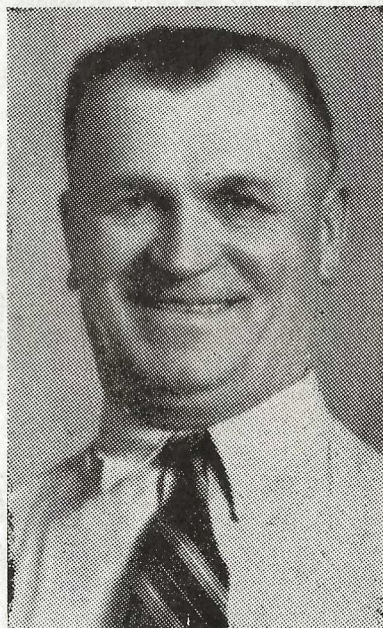

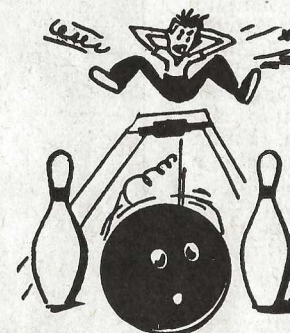

Memories of 1917 State Tournament at Anaconda, Mont.



Anaconda Making Plans to Entertain State Bowling Tournament for First Time Since 1917 April 4 to 22

After a lapse of two years, the Montana State Bowling tournament will resume in 1945, scheduled April 4 to 22 in Anaconda. This is Anaconda's first state bowling tournament since 1917. The first state bowling tournament was in Great Falls in 1916 with seven teams. In 1941 there were 237 teams in the tournament at Butte.

In the 1917 tournament there were 24 teams. P. J. Finnegan, widely known Anaconda businessman, was the president and the late George C. Jackson was secretary.

A feature of the tournament this year will be a team of 1917 tournament oldtimers bowling on the first shift. These include Finnegan, Hans Borgen, Sam Davidson, Ed Wenger and Steve Mikich.

Two men who have bowled in all state tournaments, Steve Ugrin of Anaconda and Mike Lin-

nane of Great Falls will be here.

A review of the teams in 1917 recalls many prominent state bowlers. Anaconda's ten teams were: Walnuts—Hutchens, Crosby, Lindig, Kelly, Thomas; Butchers—Pedersen, Staudohar, Schlichting, Flint and Wenger; Old Timers—Nell, Williams, Jackson, Coleman, Fulmor; Washoes—Tijan, Tretheway, Pickard, Mikich, W. M. Kelly; Federals One—Zarich, Stanich, Bernard, Hunthausen, Jesic; Federals Two

—Sullivan, McEachran, Brisenden, Kiely, Blanchard; Smelter City—Kocher, Clinton, Bowers, Petritz, Hardy; Harps—McGuire, Mooney, McDermott, Sheridan; Keystones — Lesky, Davidson, Farrell, Latimer, Chumrau; Brunswicks — Patterson, Finnegan, Borgen, Vautrin and McLean.

Arthur Vautrin of Anaconda led in individual scoring for all events with 1,766. The Great Falls Home Plates had 2,791 to lead five-man team events. Lattimer of Anaconda and Tuss of Great Falls led two-man team events with 1,202. Sherman of Lewistown had 626 for high singles and Clinton, Anaconda, had high single game with 269.

Two-man teams — Lattimer, Anaconda; Tuss, Great Falls, 1,202; Beveridge-Opp, Helena, 1,144; Vautrin-Patterson, Anaconda, 1,143; F. Mudro-Pasco, Butte, 1,142; Anderson, Jovich, Butte, 1,120.

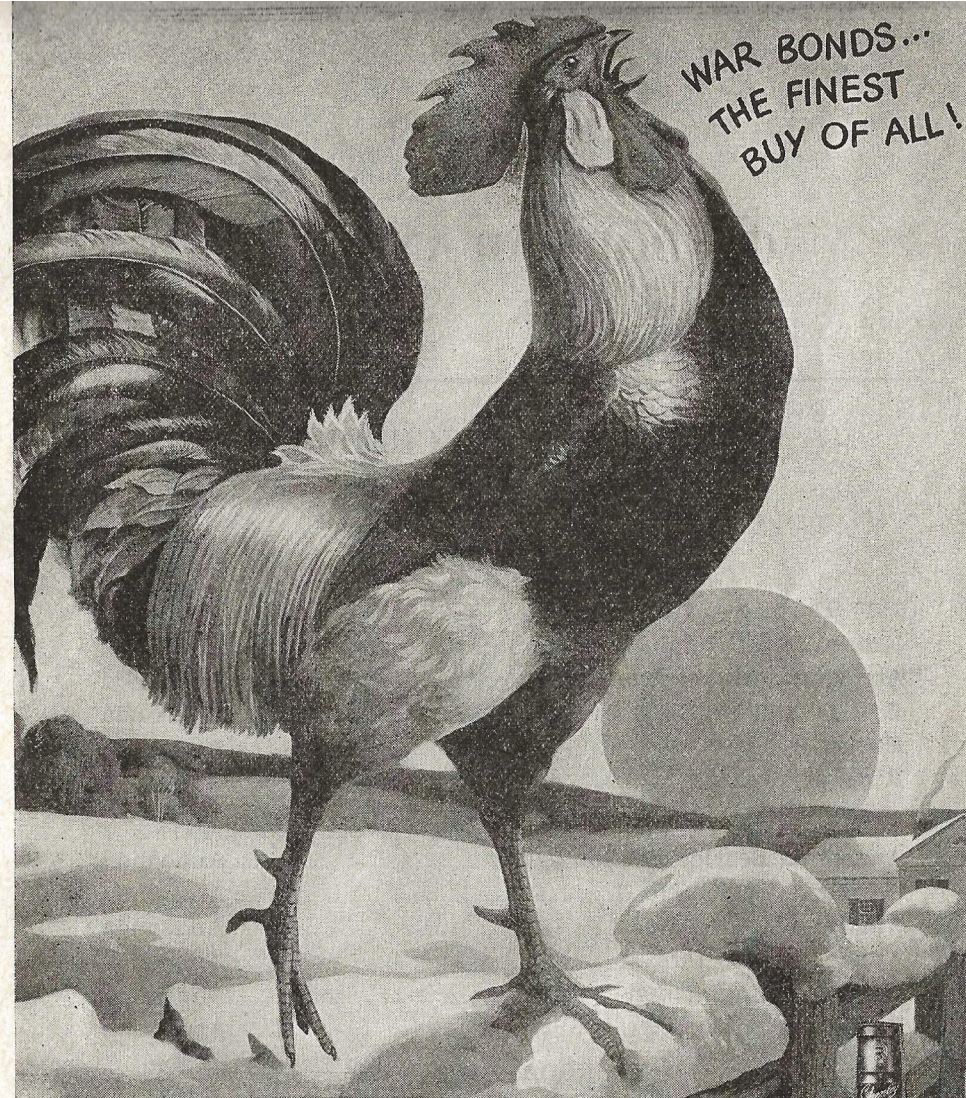

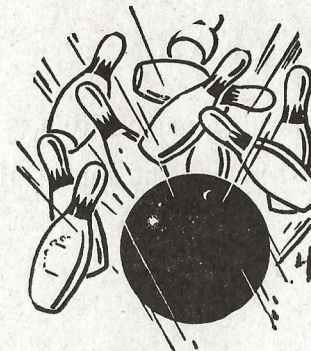
ETIQUETTE FOR BOWLERS

1. Each bowler has as his obligation the maintenance of the approaches in as nearly perfect condition as possible. Bowling shoes, although not absolute essentials, are important to the extent that they should not be substituted for shoes which are likely to leave marks on the runways. Burnt matches, ashes and other refuse should be deposited in suitable receptacles. In no instance should anything of either solid or fluid nature be permitted on the approaches. Good approach conditions can best be maintained by a healthful respect by each bowler for the rights of other bowlers.

2. When bowling one should use either his own ball or one selected from the rack. In no instance should one attempt to use a ball which is being used by another bowler. If one must bowl with a ball which is in use he should wait until the one bowling it quits bowling thereby releasing it for use by others.

3. In both practice and match bowling the bowler on your right should be given the opportunity to bowl first. To grant this opportunity, one should stand far back in a relaxed position.

4. One should strive to win by good bowling on his part rather than poor bowling on the part of the opponent. An expression of this type is the only one which connotes true sportsmanship.
