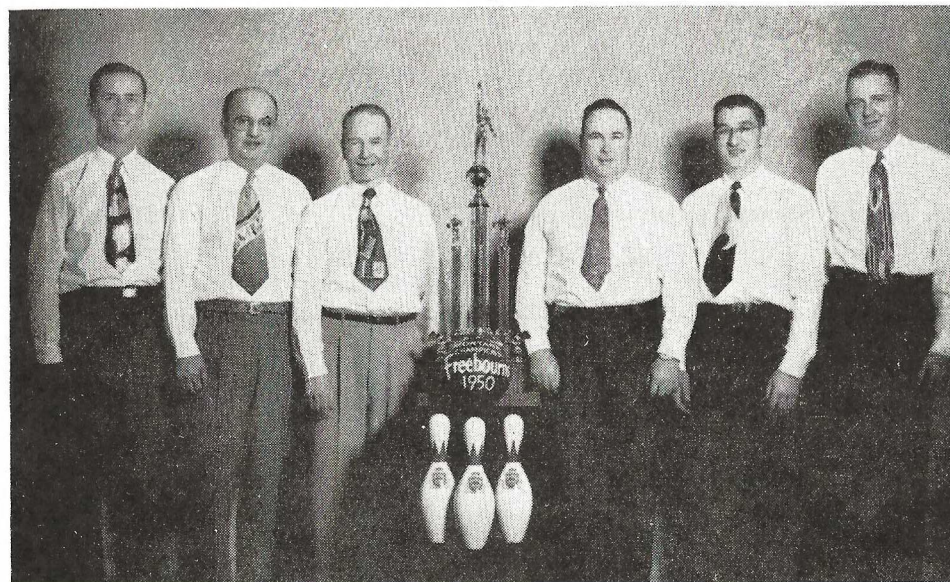

AUGUST TUSS

August bowled in the first state tournament in 1916 at Lewistown. Also in 1917 he was the doubles champion with Lattimer of Anaconda, with a 1210 total. He has bowled in almost every state tournament since then, until 1948 when he had to retire from bowling due to his health. During all of his years of bowling he will be remembered for putting the maximum effort into the game and getting the maximum of enjoyment out of it.



In state tournament competition he has been on four state champion teams — 1923, 1925, 1926 and 1942. Each time he was on an A. C. M. team. With his son, Walter, they were a great father and son combination in the doubles. They won the state doubles crown in 1938, in Helena, with 1281 for the record at the time. Also in 1940, in Havre, they won with 1264. In 1946, at Missoula, they shot the state record total of 1369, making him eight times champion, more than any other man.

Also, for many years, he has competed in the Northwest International Bowling Congress tournaments in the northwest, placing high in the different events many times. In 1939, teamed again with son Walter, they shot 1332 for the doubles crown and also the record which still stands. The same day he shot 695 for second in the singles, one of the highest totals he has ever shot. In A. B. C. competition, he and Walter shot 1277 for 25th place at St. Paul, in 1941. They also bowled in the Los Angeles A. B. C., in 1947.

He is well known throughout Montana and the northwest, being remembered for his big cigar and fighting spirit. The extent of his bowling now is to watch the leagues and tournaments in action and wonder why the fellows can't hit better scores, although conditions seem to be a little harder these days.

TOURNAMENTS OF OLD

High Records for Bowlers to Shoot At

Mudros of Butte Have Team Mark, Roundup Has All-Events, Butte Has Singles and Deer Lodge the Doubles

When the elite of Montana bowlers, the class and number of which grows rapidly each year, swing into action for the tenth annual state tournament here March 22-27, inclusive, they will have many high marks to shoot at.

Of the four records that stand out alone three were made in state tournament rolled on the "Y" alleys at Butte in 1924. Mudro Grills of Butte, copping the team event for the fourth time with a high score of 2962. Charlie Mudro set a singles record of 675 and Wallis and Shaddock of Deer Lodge crashed the maples in the doubles for a total of 1253 pins.

Vance Cebuhar of Roundup on the last day of 1921 meet, ran up a total of 1950 pins for the all-event honors, setting a mark that has as yet never been threatened and in doing it rolled nine games with a score of over 200 in each.

Winners in the 1920, '21, '22, '23 and '24 Montana State bowling tournaments—the 1920 meet having been held in Missoula, those of 1921-22-24 in Butte and that of 1923 in Great Falls—are listed below. During 1918 and 1919 no tournaments were held, while records cannot be found of the first two state series—at Great Falls in 1915 and Anaconda in 1916.

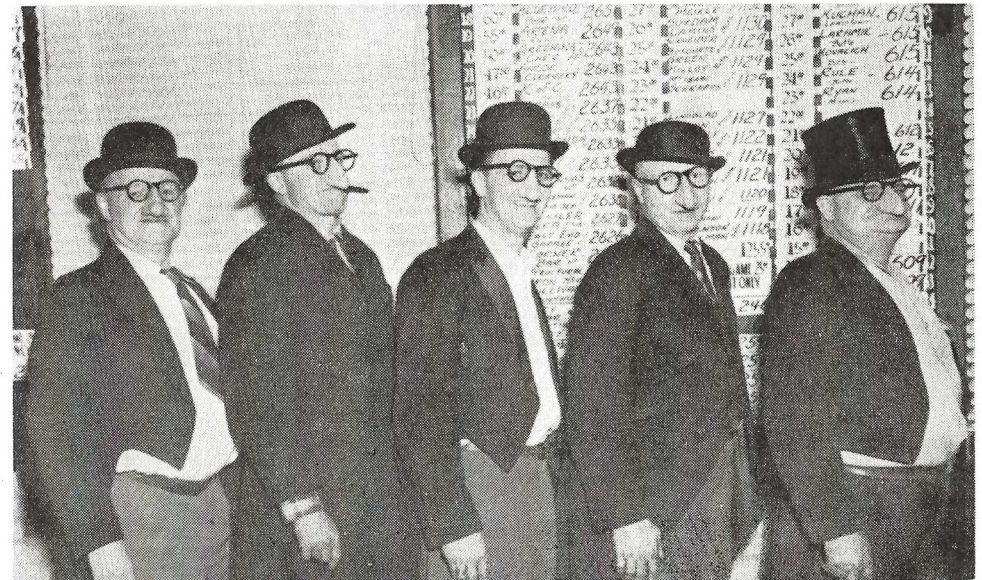

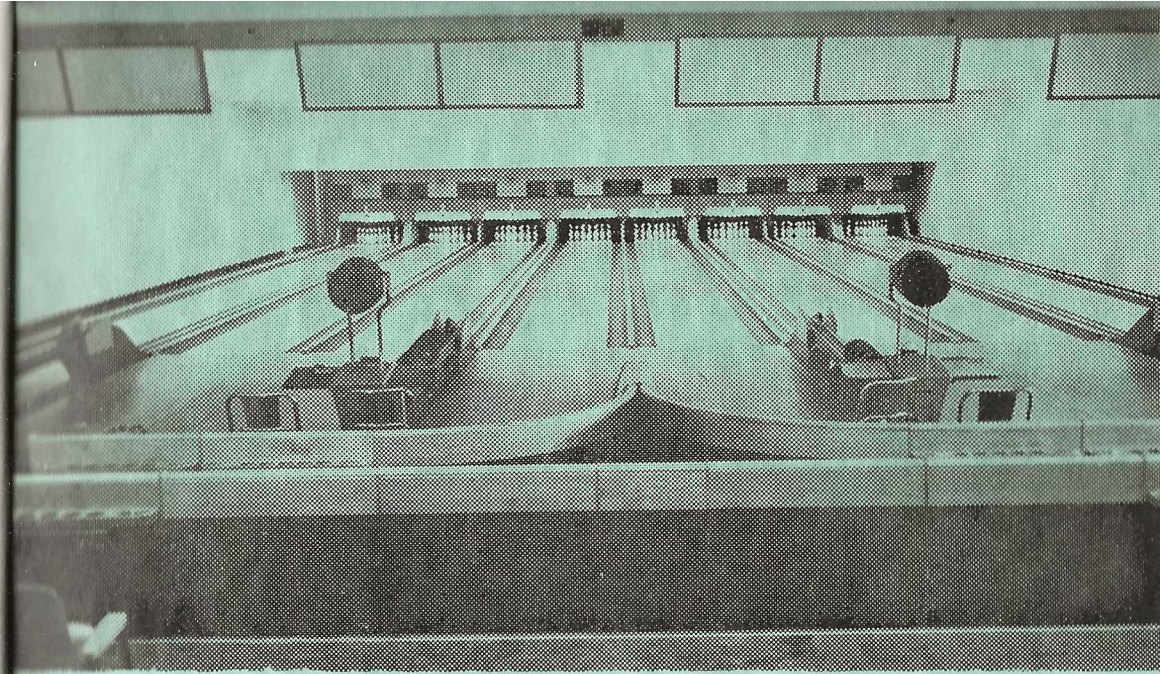
