## History of the Montana State Tournament

Records of the first State Tournament are scarce. Most programs show that it was held in Great Falls in 1915 or 1916, although the 1951 program shows it in Lewistown in 1916. Earlier "State" Tournaments were held, but not of the format we have today. In 1902, a State Tournament was held in Butte at the Thornton and Pfister Alleys, with seven three-man teams participating. Each team rolled a series against each of the other six teams, with the winners knocking down 10,012 pins.

The second State Tournament was held in Anaconda, February 22-24, 1917. Rudy Swanson, Anaconda's 72-year-old State Hall of Fame member, has a program entitled "Second Annual Banquet of the Montana State Bowling Association." This banquet was held at Gregson Springs (where Fairmont Resort is now located) on February 24, 1917. There was no 1918 tournament because of World War I.

Only open events were held until 1927, when a booster team event was added. Booster doubles, singles and all events were added in 1933, and then dropped. In 1937, The Montana State Bowling Association decided that future tournaments would have three divisions; Open (A), 825 (B) and 750 (C), and that there would again be booster doubles, singles and all events. Also, at this same meeting an interesting resolution was passed—that the State Association would request that the host alleys use 3 lb.-4 oz. "Maples" instead of the 3 lb. wood that many were using.

In 1938, the Montana State Bowling Association was reorganized in Billings as a permanent organization. No previous tournaments had been ABC sanctioned, so 300 games rolled in 1935 and 1937 were not recognized by ABC. Since 1939, all state tournaments have been ABC sanctioned.

There were two booster teams, one booster doubles and singles, and two booster all events divisions, plus the open divisions, in the 1940 tournament. In 1941, another booster doubles and singles and another booster all events division were added. Then in 1942, the tournament was again changed so that there were three divisions—one open and two booster—in each event. No tournament was held in the years 1943 and 1944 due to World War II.

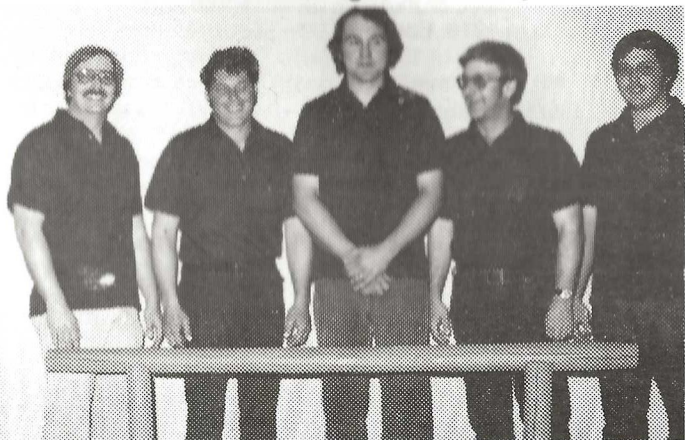
While earlier booster divisions were apparently scratch, those since 1945 have been handicapped. From 1945 through 1962, there was only one booster division. In 1959, the handicap was based on 66-2/3% of the difference between average and 169 for singles, 338 for doubles, and 845 for team.

Three divisions, all handicapped, were used in the 1963 tournament. From 1964 to 1974, the top division was again open. In 1973, a third booster division at 145 and under was added. This was raised to 150 and under in 1974. The present tournament format has been used since 1975: all divisions are handicapped based on 80% of 210 scratch. The A division is for 180 and over average bowlers, the B division for 166-179 averages, the C division for 151 to 165 averages, and the D division for 150 and under averages.

(Note: Most of the above data was gleaned from the records of Rudy Swanson of Anaconda. Much additional data was supplied from bowling data from the files of Herb Carlson and Melvin Ulstad, Anaconda's 1979 State Hall of Fame inductees; and from George Mudro and Henry Kuecks of Butte. If any bowler reviewing this history and the other records contained in this program has any of the missing data, he is asked to please pass such information on through his local association delegate to the State Association, or to mail it to Ed STrommen, 1600 West Park, Anaconda, Montana 59711. Copies of programs, entry forms, prize lists, financial statements and newspaper clippings will all help greatly to rebuild the State Association's records of past tournaments.)
