MTUSBC Tournament Standing Rules (Applicable to ALL MTUSBC sponsored adult tournaments)

1. **Tournament Eligibility (USBC Rule 300c)** – All entrants must be members of USBC residing or bowling in the area of a local association certified within the Montana USBC Association.
2. **Team Captains (USBC Rule 304)** – Team captains are to have their team members present no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled squad time. Proof of current USBC membership must be provided if requested.
3. **Prize Fund Distribution (USBC Rule 309)** – All prize funds will be distributed within 30 days of the close of the tournament. A prize list will be transmitted (via e-mail or regular mail) to each bowling center and local association manager. Preliminary and final results will be posted on bowlmontana.com.
4. **Entries Close (USBC Rule 310)** – Entries in all MTUSBC sponsored tournament will close after the start of competition, as specified in the particular tournament rules, but in no case close later than forty-five (45) minutes prior to the start of the last scheduled squad. Entrants in a particular tournament who have not exceeded their multiple participation limits prior to the tournament's specified entry closing will be allowed to enter those events (where their limits have not been exceeded) by submitting an entry form and associated entry fees to the tournament director. Squad time scheduling after the tournament's entry closing will be on an "as available" basis.
5. **Submitting Entries (USBC Rule 311)** – Entries will be scheduled according to requests in the order received, if possible. The tournament schedule will not be changed by the tournament director except for emergencies. Confirmation of squad times and dates will be made via e-mail, if available or by regular mail to the team captain designated on the entry form.
6. **Entry Refunds (USBC Rule 314)** – Entry fees will not be refunded except when an alternate time, other than requested, has been assigned and the entering team has been notified of the new time. The entering team has ten (10) days from the date stamped/transmitted on the confirmation letter to refuse the alternate time. Absolutely no refunds after the tournament starting date.
7. **Entering Average (USBC Rule 319a)** – A bowler must use the higher of his/her 2015-16 final season average (summer leagues included) or their January 1, 2017, average. A bowler without a certified 2015-16 winter or summer league average, or a January 1, 2017 average may use their current average as of the date bowled providing they have attained at least 21 games. In this case, an average verification letter from the participant's league secretary or local Association Manager will be required. All averages are for a 21 game minimum. If a bowler's final 2015-16 regular, summer, or January 1, 2017 certified league average was attained in a league bowling outside Montana, an average verification letter from that league's local Association Manager will be required. **USBC Rule 319a2 is waived.** All other aspects of rule 319 are in effect. If no rule book is available go to website: bowl.com.
8. **Assigned Averages (USBC Rule 319b)** – A participant without an entering average will be assigned an average appropriate to the handicap being used in the tournament.
9. **Average Adjustments (USBC Rule 319c)** is in effect. **All bowlers must report any previous tournament adjustment/rerate.**
10. **Sport to Standard Tournament (USBC Rule 201c)** - A bowler must submit and use his/her adjusted Sport Bowling League average if he/she does not have a Standard league average from the same season. Please read and understand all of the conditions of this rule.
11. **Tardy Players (USBC Rule 322a)** – Bowlers arriving after competition has officially begun, will not be allowed to make-up frames missed and will receive a score of zero (0) for each frame missed.
12. **Lineup Changes (USBC Rule 324a)** – Substitutes are allowed. Substitutions must be made to the tournament director as early as possible, but in any case, no later than 45 minutes prior to the start of assigned squad time. Average verification must accompany substitutions. Substitutes will NOT be furnished by the hosting association, except in the case of an emergency. In emergency situations, the substituting bowler must take the lineup place of the original bowler and will not be required to reimburse the original bowler's entry fee.
13. **Scoring Errors (USBC Rule 327b)** – Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament director within 48 hours of the completion of the squad bowled.
14. **Protests and Appeals (USBC Rule 329)** – The Montana USBC Board of Directors and the Tournament Manager shall have the power to hear and act on all protests and appeals arising from or under construction of the rules for Montana USBC sponsored tournament. The joint committee shall also decide any questions not covered by tournament rules. All protests and appeals concerning eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director before tournament prize payments are made.
15. **Improper Conduct (USBC Rule 17b)** – Participants need to be aware of this rule and the five sub-parts to it. **USBC Rule 115a (Using foul language)** closely parallels improper conduct also. Anyone violating these rules are subject to having their membership suspended.

2017 Open Championship Tournament Rules

Tournament Format – The tournament is USBC certified and will consist of two bowled events – a four (4) person Team event and a combined two (2) person Doubles event and an individual one (1) person Singles event. Bowlers may participate in either the Team or the combined Doubles/Singles events or both events. Bowlers participating in the Doubles event must bowl in the Singles event.

Team Composition – In the Team event, teams may be comprised of any combination of men and women, totaling four (4) bowlers. In the Doubles event, teams may be comprised of two (2) men or women or one (1) man and one (1) woman totaling two (2) bowlers.

Divisions – The tournament is divided into three divisions. Each division is based on the total team average of the participants competing in the event as shown on the front of this form.

Handicap – Handicap for all divisions will be based on 90% of 235 and computed using the team average method.

Phone or E-mail Entry Reservations – Squad time reservations will be accepted, however, entry form and fees must be received by the tournament director not later than 14 days of the reservation or the squad time will be vacated. Incomplete entry forms or fees will be accepted but not scheduled until all entry information and/or fees are received.

Prize Ratios - The prize ratio will be at least one (1) to five (5) or major fraction thereof for the Team event; the prize ratio will be at least one (1) to eight (8) or major fraction thereof for the Doubles/Singles events. Prize money will be returned 100%. Last paid place on the prize list will be equal to the prize fee paid. Championship awards in each division will be presented to each member of the Team, Doubles, and Singles events bowling the highest score. Championship awards will not be presented to winners in the optional events. The cost of the awards will be from the expense fees paid. Duplicate awards will be made in case of ties.

Special Events – The following optional special events are offered in this tournament. The entry fees for these events will be included in the prize fund for the event and returned 100%.

Scratch Team	\$ 28.00	1:8	Scratch score of all team entrants in any Team event. Must enter as a team.
Scratch All-Events	\$ 5.00	1:20	Combined scratch scores of first Team event and Doubles /Singles event; all entrants combined in a single division.
Scratch Doubles	\$ 7.00	1:8	Combined scratch scores of event entrant and partner in Doubles portion of the Doubles/Singles event. Both partners must enter.
Scratch Singles	\$ 7.00	1:8	Scratch score of event entrant in the Singles portion of the Doubles/Singles event.

Entries Close (USBC Rule 310) – Entry deadline is Sunday, May 21, 2017, prior to the start of the last scheduled shift, which is 12:30 p.m. for team event and 11:30 a.m. for doubles/singles. Any entry forms not accompanied by the fees required for the events entered will be accepted but not scheduled until all fees are received.

Multiple Participation (USBC Rule 315) – A bowler may participate in the Team event an unlimited number of times but at least two (2) players must be different. A bowler may participate in the combined Doubles/Singles event once.

Entering Average (USBC Rule 319a) – A bowler must use the higher of his/her 2015-16 final season average (summer leagues included) or their January 1, 2017, average. A bowler without a certified 2015-16 winter or summer league average, or a January 1, 2017 average may use their current average as of the date bowled. **All averages are for a 21 game minimum.** To verify an alternate average, an average verification letter from the participant's league secretary or local Association Manager will be required. If a bowler's final 2015-16 regular, summer, or January 1, 2017 certified league average was attained in a league bowling outside Montana, an average verification letter from that league's local Association Manager will be required.

Assigned Averages (USBC Rule 319b) – A participant without an entering average will be assigned an average of 235.

USBC Rule 319a (2) is waived. Current averages that are 10 pins or more higher than the entering average do not need reporting. The average affidavit form is no longer required. However, all other aspects of USBC Rule 319 are in effect.

USBC Rule 319c Average Adjustments is in effect. **ALL BOWLERS MUST REPORT ANY PREVIOUS TOURNAMENT ADJUSTMENT/RERATE. This is new this year.**

Annual BVL/VA Bowling Tournament. The lure of friendly competition and a test of talent draw hundreds of participants each year to this tournament sponsored for all veterans connected to the VA Healthcare System. The event, held over a four-week period each spring, offers a number of segmented divisions including ones for patients with special physical challenges, as well as age, to help level the playing field.

Support for National Veterans Competitions. For decades, BVL has been a committed sponsor of six national veteran's competitions; the National Veterans Wheelchair Games, the Veterans Golden Age Games, the Creative Arts Festival, the Training-Exposure-Experience Tournament and the Summer and Winter Sports Festivals. Each one of these events brings together veterans from around the country and provides them with an opportunity of a lifetime.

Lanes for the Troops. This is a portable carpet lane with rubberized bowling ball and pins that the men and women can set up quickly and enjoy hours of fun. This program is very popular with the troops with regular requests for kits. It is a great gift to your area VA Medical Center or State Veterans Home, too.

As you've just heard, the programs provided by the Bowlers to Veterans Link are as varied as the veterans we serve. For our World War II veterans, BVL dollars help purchase activity kits, which help pass the time and keep mentally sharp, while our younger veterans returning home from Afghanistan benefit from supplies and equipment which challenge their bodies and minds to stay strong and healthy. Whether it's bowling tournaments, craft sales, car washes or raffling baked goods, BVL volunteers are doing what they can to support America's veterans. More than that, BVL leaders also spend countless hours volunteering in VA Hospitals and other facilities. Some participate in scheduled book readings, others help with parties and special events like bingo, and still others make sure that the veterans get out to various activities which enrich their lives.

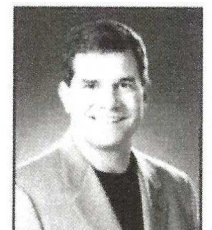

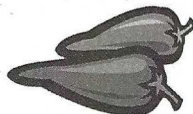
